



School Meals

Our school dinner provision is cooked and delivered to school by the catering team at Albrighton Primary School. They have put together a new set of menus for the coming term, featuring many of our pupils' favourite dishes along with some variations to take advantage of the fresh seasonal produce available. The meals are then served by our own lunchtime supervisory assistants in the village hall. The menus are on a 2 week rota and a copy of the menus can be requested from the school office.

We would hope that you will continue to support the school's catering service by purchasing a meal which we believe is excellent value at just £2.50 a day. Payments for school meals must be via Shropshire Council 'Pay It' portal as they will become a cashless authority from 1st April 2023. Cash will not be accepted.

We also hope you will encourage your child to take up their free meal entitlement, with the introduction of the 'Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals Initiative' for all children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2.

Special diets also form an important part of the catering provision we offer, catering for those children with an intolerance to specific foods, for example:

- Food Intolerance
- Food Allergy
- Food Aversion
- Medical Conditions
- Ethnic Minority Groups
